COVID PROTOCOLS/PROCEDURES

As per federal/provincial legislation, masks are no longer required in any of our common areas or to stay at the inn. Furthermore, proof of vaccination is not required to stay, dine or participate in any of the activities offered here at Bonnie View Inn. With that being said, your safety and the safety of other guests and our staff members is paramount to us. We ask for your understanding and flexibility as we navigate the ever-changing rules and regulations associated with Covid-19.

ROOM AMENITIES

Your room will be made with clean linens and towels. The pullout sofa will not be made up unless you have requested us to do so in advance.

Your room is equipped with: bar fridge, 7cu microwave (except inn rooms there is one in the hall to share), satellite TV, coffee maker with decaf/ regular coffee pods, kettle with tea bags, fan, iron & board, coffee/water cups, shampoo and soap.

*We DO NOT have kitchens in any of our accommodation and your room is NOT equipped with kitchen items. Please bring your own plates, cutlery & serving utensils. If you have take out and you need a plate/cutlery please come see us at the desk. For power and insurance reasons you cannot bring your own appliances.

HOUSEKEEPING

Due to Covid-19 and for the safety of our guests and staff, we have suspended our daily room cleaning. However, our housekeeping team will stop by your room daily to see if you need anything. If you are out when they stop by, you can come to the front desk during front desk hours or simply text/call us with any needs. If you wish for us to dispose of the garbage in your room, please put your items outside of your room **before** 3PM. Alternatively, you can use

the garbage/recycling receptacles located around the property. Also, if you would like replacement towels, use the laundry bag hanging in your closet and hang the dirty towels in the bag outside your room before 3PM.

LOBBY TUCK SHOP/BV MERCH

Complimentary coffee and tea are served all day in the lobby during desk hours. We also have a selection of snacks, drinks, toiletries and Bonnie View merchandise! Scan the <u>QR code</u> for a link to our shop.



ICE

Your ice bucket is in the fridge in your room. Bring it to the lobby between 8am-8pm to fill it using our ice machine.

WATER

Our water is safe to drink. Before it gets to your taps it goes through a robust filtration system. It is tested daily. The hot water for most rooms travels a bit of a distance so if need be, run the hot water in your sink for a few minutes.

FIREPLACES

We do not permit the use of real wood for burning in any of our fireplaces. We have fire logs for sale at the front desk for \$5 each. There is a \$200 fine for burning real wood.

ONSITE DINING-reservations are required at the least 24 hours in advance for both meals, we do get busy & if you leave it too late, we may not be able to serve you.

ONSITE ACTIVITIES/EQUIPMENT

Use of non-motorized boats, sports equipment and water toys is included with your stay. Paddle boards, kayaks, canoes, and peddle boats are all locked up on the beach docks. You must sign them out/in each time you would like to use them. The signout sheet is located in the lobby. Life jackets, paddles and safety kits are located in the shed adjacent to the firepit at the bottom of the boat ramp. Please be courteous to other guests and return keys to the lobby as soon as you are finished with the boat. If there are any issues with the boats or safety gear please let us know right away at the front desk. You also have access to beach volleyball, basketball, horseshoes, and cornhole (bean bag

toss). You will find the equipment needed for each of these activities located at each site.

SATELLITE TV

All of our accommodations come outfitted with satellite tv. A channel guide and instructions for the use of your TV can be requested at the front desk.

GAMES/MOVIES

We have a good selection of board games, card games, etc in the lobby and lounge. You are welcome to take these back to your room and return them when you are finished.

We have a collection of DVDs that are available to our guests. Stop by the lobby to take a look at our collection. DVDs players are not hooked up in any of the rooms but you can sign one out and take it back with you to your room.

BONFIRES

We have a lakeside bonfire pit at the end of the boat ramp/toboggan hill. A fire can be lit after the hour of 7PM. In the shed adjacent you will find wood, newspaper, kindling & roasting sticks. The bonfire is a shared space available to all of our guests. Pull up a chair and enjoy the scene. If you need help starting a fire please let us know.

ALCOHOL

You are permitted to drink your own alcohol in or outside your room. However, you cannot bring your own drinks into any of our licensed areas (lounge, patio, dining room). Please do not carry glass around the property - bare feet and glass do not go well together. We have paper cups at the front desk if you need some.

BARBECUES

There are four barbecues located around the property. They are available for guest use on a first come first serve basis. Please be courteous of other guests and clean the grill after your use. If you need utensils, lighter or anything else for the bbgs please visit us at the front desk.

HIKING TRAIL

To access our marked hiking trail turn right out of the main parking lot and follow the road to mailbox #2685. Directly across from the mailbox on the other side of the road will be the opening of the trail. Follow the trail and the arrows until you hit the end. A sign will send you down the snowmobile trail and back to the main road. Turn right and head back to BV.

SMOKING POLICY

All indoor spaces are considered non-smoking and non-vaping. You CANNOT smoke on your suite balcony/walkout, on the beach or in any area that could affect other guests. The designated and marked smoking area is in the parking lot. Smoking/vaping indoors will result in a \$1,000 fine.

EXCESSIVE NOISE

Please respect other guests by keeping noise and music to a reasonable level after 9:00pm. There is a noise bylaw on our lake. No excessive noise at any time. Violators risk a fine up to \$1,000.

BOAT LAUNCH/PARKING/TRAILERS

Please let us know in advance if you are bringing your own boat & need to use the docks. Our dock space is extremely limited but we will do our best to accommodate. We charge \$20/day or \$100/wk. For insurance reasons we cannot allow you to use the ramp onsite. However, there is a public boat launch only 1/2 km down the road towards Minden.
